The Weather is getting cooler so the ALR Riders will be out in force now, it seems as though we have rides almost every weekend coming up.

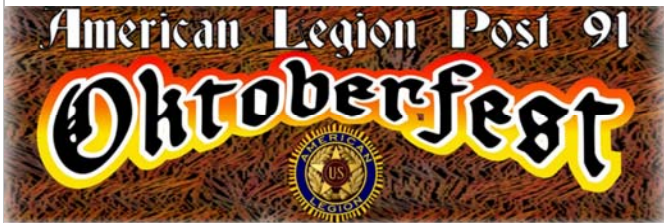

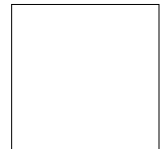
