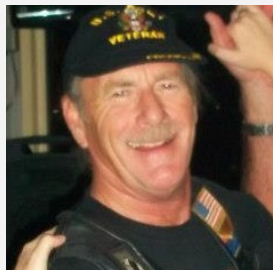
United States military the additional charge would only be \$10.

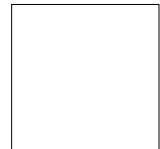
