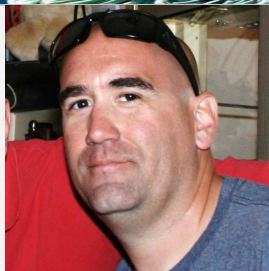

Its tis the season for reporting. The Unit will be working on reports early in April. PLEASE send in your hours/mileage/money you have done this year. You can email them to me or leave them at the

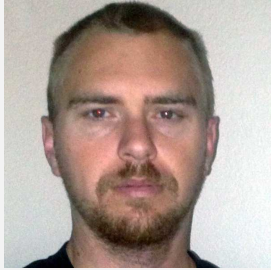
Post or snail mail them me. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact me.

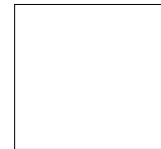
